ORDINANCE NO. 28

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR A CURFEW IN THE EVENT OF A DECLARED EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama, as follows:

Section 1. When in the judgment of the Mayor and the Town Council of the Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama, an emergency is deemed to exist, the Mayor may order a general curfew applicable to such geographical areas of the Town, or to the Town as a whole, as deemed advisable, and applicable during such hours of the day or night as directed by the Mayor, and subject to such other conditions, limitations and exemptions as deemed necessary in the interest of the public's health, safety and welfare.

Section 2. Curfew as used herein is defined as a prohibition against any one or more persons from walking, running, loitering, standing, motoring or traveling upon any alley, street, highway, public property or vacant premises within the Town, except persons officially designated to duty with reference to such emergency. An emergency as used herein is defined as any natural disaster or man-made calamity, including such events as flood, cyclone, tornado, hurricane, earthquake, explosion or riot within the Town resulting in the death or injury of persons or the destruction of property to such an extent that extra-ordinary measures must be taken to protect the public's health, safety and welfare.
