

- (2) **Two (2) year tag for Part-Time residents**
 - (a) must provide a residential address
 - (b) proof of residence required (power bill or water bill) If voter registration card or driver license does not have a Dauphin Island address; they are **Part-Time** residents.
- (3) **One (1) year tag for renters.**
 - (a) signed statement from owner or landlord providing physical address and identification of renter required.
 - (b) renter must provide power bill, water bill, or phone bill.
- (4) **One (1) year tag for Business Owner/Business Employees**
 - (a) Business owner must supply a list of employees who reside off of Dauphin Island
 - (b) Owner, if required, must provide proof of business interest in Town.
- (5) **One (1) year tag for unimproved property owners**
 - (a) must adequately describe location of unimproved property (example: lot and block number).

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- (6) **One (1) year tag for Contractors**
 - (a) must have current business license on Dauphin Island

**TEMPORARY
PAPER PERMIT**

- (7) **Three (3) month tag for Workers/Helpers**
 - (a) work passes will be issued on an as need basis
 - (b) signed statement identifying worker/helper from business, resident/home owner presented before issuance.

SECTION 4.

IMPROPER USE OR DISTRIBUTION OF TAGS

Re-entry tags will indicate the resident's address and an E for east end of the island and W for west end of the island. Unauthorized use, alteration, copying, forging or sale of emergency evacuation re-entry tags will constitute a misdemeanor, and upon conviction a person may be fined not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment for a period not to exceed six (6) months.

SECTION 5.

ISSUANCE FEES

A fee in the amount of five dollars (\$5.00) per tag issued will be charged.

SECTION 6.

LOST/STOLEN TAGS


Replacement tags will be issued upon certification of loss and payment of a replacement fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) per tag.
